Regulatory divergence	Following Brexit, the UK may gradually diverge from EU competition law.

Investigations by competition authorities	The EU Commission and UK Competition and Markets Authority may conduct parallel investigations into UK-EU activity.
Competition litigation	Pursuing litigation in the UK for infringements of EU competition law may become more difficult.
